

Dear Westside Community Center Neighbors & Guests,

While we were "holding out hope" that we would be able to keep our doors open in order to offer a safe, healthy, positive place for our neighbors to interact, we are forced to make further changes to prioritize the health and safety of our neighbors, staff, and greater community during this ongoing global pandemic.

With El Paso County's recent surge in COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations, the county will move to the state's "Level Red - Severe Risk" status, effective 5pm, Friday, November 27. Consequently, the Westside Community Center will operate on a very limited service basis for the duration of this restriction level.

Effective Friday, November 27, at 5:00pm, the Westside Community Center will operate the following programs:

1. **Silver Keys Connections Cafe**: "Take & Go"/curbside pick-up, packaged meal service on Tuesdays, 10:00-11:00am. Please make reservations with Silver Key (719) 844-2300 no later than Friday.
2. YMCA Day Camp

The Main Office will remain monitored; if you need assistance please do not hesitate to call (719) 385-7920 and we will return your call as soon as possible. It allows us to continue essential services while reducing people's risk of exposure to COVID-19 during a time when local cases and hospitalizations are spiking.
